



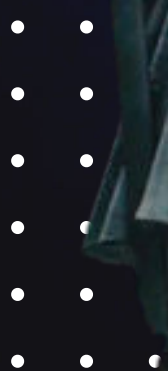

ABOUT C.P. SUDHAKARA PRASAD

Late Senior Advocate C.P. Sudhakara Prasad was the former Advocate General of Kerala. He served as the All India Lawyers Union's State President and Vice President. Hailing from Chavarcodes near Varkala, C.P. Sudhakara Prasad served dutifully as the Advocate General (AG) for two terms. He was first appointed as AG by the LDF government of VS Achuthanandan and served from 2006 to 2011. His second term was from 2016 to 2021, during the first Pinarayi Vijayan government, and he was assigned cabinet rank.

He graduated from Government Law College in Thiruvananthapuram in 1964 and began his legal career in Kollam under C.V. Padmarajan, a former Minister. He moved his practice to Ernakulam, where he worked for Justice P Subramanian Poti, who later became Chief Justice of Kerala and the Gujarat High Court. He then began practising independently and specialized in service and Constitutional Law. The High Court designated him as Senior Advocate in 2002. He served as Chairman of the Bar Council of Kerala from 2016 to 2019.

ABOUT ALL INDIA LAWYERS UNION

ALL INDIA LAWYERS UNION was formed 39 years ago under the patronage and guidance of Justice V. R. Krishna Iyer, Justice H. R. Khanna and Justice A.C. Gupta, who were the icons of the Indian judiciary. The 400 lawyers who attended the preparatory meeting held in New Delhi on 13th April 1982 were further emboldened by the

charismatic presence of the then Chief Minister of West Bengal and legendary leader of the working class, Comrade Jyoti Basu. Under the inspirational leadership of Senior Advocates Danial Alma Latifi and Hardev Singh, an organizing committee was elected with the mandate to convene the first National Conference within one year. The self-criticism of the lukewarm response by the lawyers to the tyranny during the National Emergency led to the formation of the progressive lawyers' organization with a clear vision. Since its formation in 1982, AILU has always remained steadfast in protecting and upholding the democratic rights of the legal fraternity and has also joined hands with the people's struggle for a brighter tomorrow.

ABOUT THE COMPETITION

The art of mooting is one of the fundamentals that a law student undertakes to become a master in law. Mooting imbibes skills like Research, Legal Writing, Critical Thinking, and Communication, which are quintessential for the development of a student as a budding lawyer. The All India Lawyers Union Ernakulam District Committee organises the 1st C.P. Sudhakara Prasad Memorial National Moot Court Competition in 2022, envisioning a bright future where mooting is an inclusive experience that enhances the legal proficiency and courtroom decorum of students. The moot problem deals with a novel concept that is pertinent in the contemporary political climate.
